First Axis – Learning, training, education

- links the processes of learning and training in academic and professional environments. The monopoly of certification is the guiding principle for “lifelong” training and training standards for teachers in IUFM.

Second Axis – Production of categories of knowledge - study of relations between secular knowledge (“public” opinions, “cultural” blockages...), technical knowledge (in institutions and businesses...), and scientific knowledge (discoveries, innovations...). The field of research concerns the diffusion of standards in child care among young mothers and the phenomenon of remission in persons affected by breast cancer (commissioned by INCA).

Third Axis – Cultures, Territories, Collective solidarity - study of the processes of reception (and qualification) of goods, practices and services on one hand, and contemporary mutations of rural societies on the other. The empirical works concern territorial cultural offerings (study of media libraries, their new patrons and new uses) on one hand, and on the other, new intergenerational heritage transmission practices (specifically supporting a “C2R” Regional Resource Center). International research supported by a BQR (Quality Research Bonus) from the University of Limoges will complete the whole. It influences strategies of business associations in Europe. GRESCO directs the work and facilitates a network of “young researchers” divided among several universities, among them Lille 1 and 2, Brussels, Limoges.
