- For your health:

The medical health center of the university remains open to the students.

Medical consultations upon request with the doctors, nurses still take place.

The time slots are the same than before: between 8AM and noon and between 1PM and 5PM. (front desk contact: **05.55.43.57.70.**)

For gynaecological issues, the appointment for non-emergency situations are postponed.

Psychiatric emergencies will take place at the general hospital (CHU).

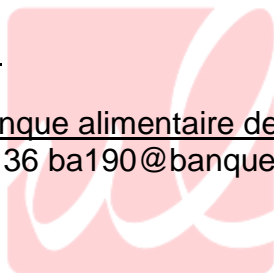
