

Assistant/Associate Professor in Economics

The University of Limoges invites applications for a position of assistant or associate professor of economics (Maître de Conférences en Sciences Economiques) at the University of Limoges, starting September 2016. The appointment is on the basis of a French civil service status.

The selected candidate will conduct his/her research at LAPE, a research laboratory dedicated to banking and finance (Director: Pr. Amine Tarazi) and will be connected to LAPE's international research network.

Job Profile: Econometrics, micro-econometrics, banking and finance

Candidates should show a solid expertise in econometrics applied to Banking and financial economics. Candidates should also have communications skills and the ability to participate to collective research programs.

The teaching load corresponds to a total of 128 hours a year. Depending on their research potential, assistant/associate professors can obtain a reduced load for the first year of their appointment. The selected candidate will teach on the Bachelor and the Master programs, primarily in English. Additional duties include advising and mentoring students and participating to departmental and school management.

Requirement

- A Ph.D. in Economics, Finance or related fields
- Strong publication record or the potential to publish in leading international journals
- Candidates who do not require a qualification from the Conseil national des universités (CNU), must hold a position in a foreign University at the time of the recruitment
- Graduates of any country are eligible. Knowledge of French is NOT required, but is a plus. French lessons are proposed to all newly recruited international faculty.
